### **History of the College :**

Lalit Chandra Bharali College (known as LCB College) was founded in 1971 as a night college by a group of teachers and operated from the premises of Maligaon Railway Higher Secondary School. At the initial stage it catered mostly to undergraduate working men and women. It was at the initiative of the neighborhood community and the generous donation made by the family of Lalit Chandra Bharali that facilitated the purchase of its own land in 1972 and it was only from that very next year that the college functioned for the first time from its own premises and since then it is the Governing Body that constitutes the primary management system of the college. The establishment of the college was driven by a holistic approach towards higher education to the marginal student community who could not access the central/city Colleges for various reasons. It was also an educational outreach for the students who lived beyond the city limits and the entire Northeast. However, since the last two decades the College has notched up its credibility as it attracts some of the best students from the entire northeast region for its non-traditional subjects at the UG level. Another advantage of the College is the natural ambience that prevails in the campus. It is nestled in the foothills of the beautiful Nilachal (abode of the Goddess Kamakhya) and Adingiri Hills providing an ideal environment for teaching and learning.

This College has a multidisciplinary nature of courses and multi dimensional activities including extra curricular activities. **Facilities on Central Library :**

The college has a well equipped library with a collection of around 21000 (twenty one thousand) text and reference books, 18 periodicals and 10 newspapers of national and international repute. It follows open access system and using SOUL software (an integrated Library Management Software) developed by INFLIBNET Centre, Ahmedabad for library automation. It also introduced Barcode for smooth running of day-to-day library works. Students are allowed to borrow books against library borrower's card. The students must follow the existing rules and regulations of the Library.

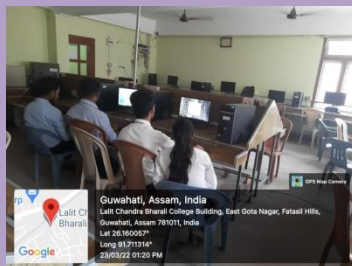

## Awards and Incentives

- a) **College Merit Prize** : Students securing the highest aggregate marks in TDC Final Examination (Arts and Science) and B.C.A. and B.Sc.(IT) will be awarded “**Late Ratneshwar Borooh Memorial Award**”, each of which carries a cash award of Rs. 5000/- and a certificate. Students securing the first position in English Honours in TDC Final Examination will be awarded “**Basanta Borooh Memorial Award**”, which carries a cash award of Rs. 6000/- and a certificate.
- b) **Students' Aid Fund** : The College has a Students' Aid Fund to help the poor but meritorious students of the College. Students having more than 75% of class attendance are eligible to apply for this aid. During 2021-22, sixteen students received financial aid from this fund.

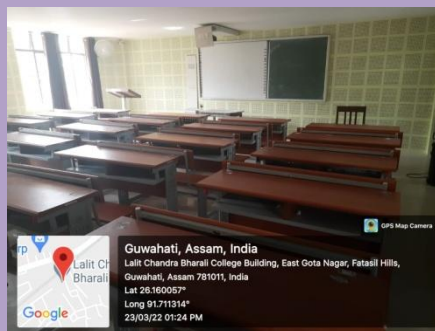
## Laboratories

- a) The Department of Computer Science has two periodically upgraded A/C Laboratories for approximately 100 students. The Department also has a Laboratory equipped with Micro-Processor Kit.
- b) The Department of Electronics has a periodically upgraded A/C Laboratory with a capacity of approximately 30 students for basic Electronics. There is a separate set-up for Digital Electronics for 20 students with its own computational facility.
- c) The Department of Physics has two fully equipped Laboratories.
- d) The Department of Education also has a Laboratory with modern equipments.
- e) The Department of Economics, Statistics and Mathematics has Laboratories with modern equipments.



### Facilities at LCB College:

- i. **Conference Hall** : A State-of-the-Art conference Hall is available for conducting Seminar, Conference, Workshop, Lecture Programmes etc.
- ii. **Photocopying** : This facility is available in the college campus.
- iii. **Magazine** : The College magazine '**LCBIAN**' is published annually. It provides a platform to students to express their views and creativity through various forms of writings.
- iv. **Audio-visual Aid** : The college has the facility of Digital Class Room. LCD projector and Sound systems are used as important aids for holding seminars, workshops and for teaching and learning process.
- v. **Power Back-up** : The college has a Power House with a capacity of 62.5 KV to meet the demand of electricity for the whole campus during power failure.
- vi. **Canteen** : Canteen facility is available within the college campus for the students, teachers and other employees. The college canteen serves hygienic and good quality food with a wide variety of availability of snacks at a reasonable price and also has a seating capacity of 40 students at one point of time.
- vii. **Campus Interview** : The college has the provision of holding on/off Campus interview for placement of the students. Different multinational companies like TCS, IBM, Wipro, Infosys, etc. have recruited a good number of students through Off Campus Interview during the last few years.
- viii. **Drinking Water** : Pure drinking water equipped with Aquaguard and cooler is available in the campus.
- ix. **Wi-Fi Campus** : The entire campus is equipped with Wi-Fi network.
- x. **Sports**: The campus has playing fields and indoor sports area.
- xi. **In Campus Hostel** : The hostel is for girl students coming from different regions of North east ,a privilege of well-secured homely atmosphere in the in-campus hostel of the college which can accommodate 53 students. The students can avail this opportunity on first come first serve basis.
- xii. **Smartboard**: Smart boards are installed in some of the classroom of the college, this amazing technology not only enhances the way teachers teach, but it also enhances the way students learn.



**Alumni Association** : An Institution of higher learning needs active co-operation and support from its Alumni for its overall growth. The college holds the Alumni meet, at least once a year and some important decisions are taken for all round growth and development of the institution. A good number of Alumni are holding prominent positions in the society. The Alumni Association of the College is registered under Society Registration Act with registration No. RS/KAM(M)/263/Z/526 of 2021-2022.

**Students' Union** : The Lalit Chandra Bharali College Students' Union (LCBCSU) is the General Body of the Students of the College. Its membership is compulsory for every student, Office bearers are elected annually as per the constitution of the Students' Union.

**Regular Evaluation System :** Sessional Tests are held on regular basis during the semesters and credits of these tests are carried over to the TDC final examinations.

**Co-Curricular Activities and Extension Education Programme :** The College considers extension work as the third dimension of institution and regards it as important as the other two dimensions viz., teaching-learning and research. This is due to the consideration that extension activities are beneficial for inculcating a sense of dedication to social upliftment and accountability among students. The college initiates extension education with its own fund. These activities are carried out through the Extension Education Cell and other cells.

### Types of Extension work

- i. **Academic Extension Activities :** The college organizes Departmental Lectures, Seminars, workshops, etc. with the involvement of existing teachers, librarian and invited experts, so that interdisciplinary knowledge can be transmitted among the teachers and the students.
- ii. **Extension through Awareness :** The college is organizing some awareness programme on different areas like Science, primary health, drug abuse, AIDS, blood donation, etc. within and outside the college campus.
- iii. **National Cadet Corps (NCC)**  
The NCC aims at instilling in the students a spirit of discipline and willingness to serve the country. Students can get themselves admitted to the NCC at the beginning of each academic year. The cadets are given regular training in the college and in the camps. Examinations are held and merit certificates are awarded. Winners are eligible for grace marks according to their grade when they apply for admission to higher classes. A sense of unity and discipline is inculcated among the cadets.

- iv. **National Service Scheme (NSS) :** The NSS is a voluntary organization of the Student under the aegis of the Union Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports established in 1989 to inculcate social consciousness and sense of responsibility, discipline and dignity of labour among the youth. The college unit of the NSS is vibrant with activities and organizing a number of health education programmes each year under the guidance of the Project Officer. **Facilitating for Upgradation:**

- i. **Suggestion Box** : Suggestions from students/ parents/ guardians/ well wishers related to the development of the College are welcome and they may drop their suggestions in the Suggestion Box.
- ii. **Grievance Box** : Grievances from students/ parents/ guardians/ well wishers are welcome and they may drop their suggestions in the grievance Box.
- iii. **Students' Feedback** : The college has designed a Student Feedback Form, through which students are asked to provide their comments regarding teaching-learning evaluation (teacher-wise) process. Information provided in this regard is analyzed by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and necessary measures are taken for improving the quality of education in the college.

**General information**

- i. Regular attendance in class is compulsory for the students. Willful absence from the class is treated as serious breach of College discipline.
- ii. A student failing to attend classes for 25 days at a stretch from the date of commencement of classes shall forfeit his/her seat.
- iii. As per GU regulation students must attend above 75% of classes to appear in the internal/external examinations.
- iv. Identity Card will be issued to each student to be kept by him/her during College hours. Any loss or damage of Identity card must be reported immediately to the college authority.
- v. Students will have to wear only the approved uniform inside the college campus.
- vi. Mobile phone must be used judiciously inside the college campus.
- vii. Ragging is strictly prohibited. Anyone found indulging in any act of Ragging will be dealt as per rules.
- viii. Any form of sexual harassment may be reported to the College Authority/ the Presiding Officer of Internal Committee (IC) by means of written complaints/ E Mail.
- ix. Students are entitled to avail student concession to travel offered by different agencies as per rule.
- x. Any notice desired to be pasted or circulated by the students anywhere in the college and hostel premises will need the prior approval of the College Authority.
- xi. All powers of maintenance of discipline are vested with the Principal and his decision shall be final in all such matters.
- xii. There is total ban of the use of (consumption and sale) GUTKHA, CIGGARETTES, ALCOHOL etc. in the college campus. Any kind of violation for the first time, will invite fine of Rs.10,000/- for Faculty and Employee and Rs. 5000/- for student. Second time violation will invite disciplinary action against the violator.
